Mr. Bandi is managing the current fund since inception.

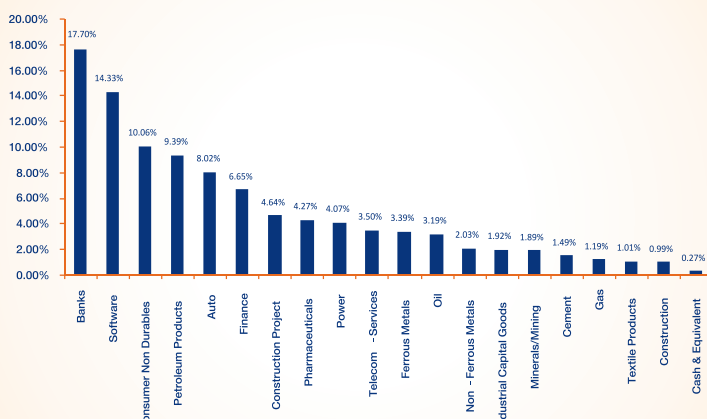
